ISLS Submission Tips

Template:

- Use the new template. Do NOT use a template from a previous conference.
 - Ensure correct paper size (A4) and margins (1.25 inch on top and bottom, 1 inch on left and right). Papers not using the new template will be sent back to authors to edit.

Author list and acknowledgements:

- Leave space for author(s) and acknowledgements on your submission so that you don't have to make cuts to the final version to make them fit.
- Write out the institutions and email addresses for each author in the author list.

Abstract:

- Use the "Abstract" style in the template. Indent 0.5 inches on the right and left margins.
 "Full justify" the text.
- Must start with the word "Abstract:" (in bold)

Title and heading capitalization:

- In the title, capitalize all major words (nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, and pronouns), including the second part of hyphenated major words (e.g., Self-Report not Self-report).
- All headings are sentence case—only the first word of a heading is capitalized.

Text formatting:

• Do not use superscripts or subscripts in any circumstance.

References

• Never put a hard return inside of a single reference. The reference list must be full justified like the rest of the document.

File-naming:

• For anonymization reasons, do not include your name or institution in your filename.
